BRIEF HISTORY

The Primary and Junior High schools were established in September 1959 and September 1988 respectively as a Private Institution by Mr. & Mrs. J.H. Mensah of blessed memory. The Pre-School was established in 2007 to nurture children to ably fit into the Primary level. The School has facilities for admitting both Day and Boarding Pupils.

MANAGEMENT

The school is managed by a Board which includes two partners of the School. The School is autonomous and receives no subsidy from anywhere.

CONDITION OF ENTRY

Interviews/Tests are conducted for admissions of Pupils into vacant places.

FEES

Successful candidates after submission of completed Application Form will have to fully settle the terms fees by the re-opening date. Administrative costs will be deducted from fee deposits should prospective parents decide to withdraw their placement. Parents with a minimum of three (3) children in the school will enjoy a discount of 10% on tuition fee with effect from 26th April, 2016

REGULATIONS

<u>*FEES*</u>: Full Payment of the term's fees should be settled by the re-opening date. Including PTA Dues, Extra Classes, Needlework practical for Primary 4 - 6 and Home Economics practical for JHS Students.

<u>WITHDRAWALS</u>: Parents/Guardians are required by regulation to give a full term's notice of intention to withdraw pupil from the school in writing. Failure to comply with this directive will compel the school to demand a full term's fee in lieu of notice.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All admission forms should be submitted with a Medical Report, Photocopies of birth and Immunization Certificate. Photocopy of Last School Report (if applicable) from the Pupil's former school together with two (2) Passport size photos should be attached.

SICK PUPILS

Parents/Guardians should refrain from sending a sick pupil to school. Report should be made to the School on such pupils.

PERMISSION TO BE ABSENT FROM SCHOOL

Permission letters (preferably written) should be addressed to the Headmistress.

FOOD FROM HOME

Pupils are not allowed to bring perishable food into the Boarding house. However, where such foods are necessary, prior approval should be sought from the Headmistress or her assistants. Day students may however come along with their lunch, if they do not wish to patronise in the school lunch at a cost.

PARENT, TEACHER ASSOCIATION (P.T.A)

Parents/Guardians or their representatives are to attend all P.T.A meetings usually held once a term.

PRESCRIBED UNIFORMS

No style of uniform other than the prescribed school uniform would be allowed. Prescribed uniforms are available for sale in the school.

VISITING

Parents and Guardians are permitted to visit their children on Saturdays and Sundays afternoon from 1:00pm to 5:30pm. During this period visitors are not allowed into the boarding houses. The same applies on Public Holidays.

Exeat (LEAVING SCHOOL)

Boarders are not allowed to leave the School campus without obtaining permission in their exeat cards from the Housemaster/Housemistress. Day students will not be allowed to go outside the school compound when school is in session. They should come to school with their meals or patronize the school's canteen.

ELECTRONIC GADGETS

Under no circumstances should pupils bring electronic gadgets to school eg. Mobile phones, radio sets, computers etc. Any of such items found on a pupil will be confiscated.

HAIRDO

Pupils who do not braid their hair should trim their hair nicely. No bushy hair will be entertained on the compound. Those who wish to braid their hair should consult the office or housemistresses for prescribed hairdo.

DISMISSAL

Pupil will be summarily dismissed for any of the following reasons;

- I. Gross indiscipline
- II. Marked inability to study
- III. Non-Payment of fees
- IV. Immoral Behaviour

REPORTING BACK TO SCHOOL FROM VACATION

Pupils who do not report on re-opening day without written permission will be punished.

TEXTBOOKS & STATIONERY

It is the responsibility of parents/ guardians to equip their children with prescribed textbooks and stationery and other logistics, which may be bought at the school. A relevant book list will be issued on a
